

## Liverpool Fact Sheet \*Updated January 2022\*

- Home to more museums and galleries than anywhere outside of London
- Liverpool has the most Grade II-listed buildings outside of London
- The Royal Albert Dock is the largest collection of Grade I-listed buildings in the UK
- A UNESCO City of Music
- Liverpool was European Capital of Culture in 2008
- A train from London Euston will take passengers to Liverpool in 2 hours
- Liverpool Chinatown is home to the largest Chinese Arch in Europe (14 metres tall)
- The Grand National takes place in Liverpool every year
- There are 6 universities accessed in Liverpool
- Liverpool is the 4th 'Friendliest City in the World'
- Liverpool is one of five national science and innovation campuses
- The clock faces on the Royal Liver Building are the largest in the country
- The most filmed city outside of London, often doubling for New York
- The world's first School of Tropical Medicine
- The world's first commercial wet dock was built in Liverpool in 1715
- Liverpool Anglican Cathedral is the largest in Britain and 5th largest in the world
- Liverpool was the first city in the world to open a lending library
- Home to both Cunard and the White Star Line
- The railway between Liverpool and Manchester was the first passenger line of its kind
- Home to two Premier League Football Clubs, Liverpool FC and Everton
- Liverpool FC have won the European Cup Six times in their history
- Home to one of the top 25 high performance computing systems in the world
- University of Liverpool is a UK centre for world-leading computer science research
- More than 50 million visitors every year
- 80 different languages are spoken to Liverpool
- The oldest Chinatown in Europe is in Liverpool
- 40% of graduates find employment in Liverpool City Region
- Over 270,000 degree level
